Mississippi Short-Term Occupational Employment Projections for 2023-2025 were produced over a period from December 2023-early March 2024. These statewide projections are made based on procedures, methods, and expectations provided by the Projections Managing Partnership in consultation with the U.S. Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration.

Projections apply a range of statistical models to determine short-term industrial trends, which affect the occupational projections. Due to confidentiality rules, some occupational data are not on this list but are part of the Major Group subtotals and Totals, All Occupations.

In general, projections assume the following as true over the projected two-year period:

- Work patterns will not change considerably
- Social and educational trends in general will carry on
- Economic activity fluctuations due to the business cycle will continue
- There will be no major recession
- There will be no major war nor significant change in the size of the Armed Forces
